Maths

Year 5 are solving problems involving multiplication and division including using their knowledge of factors and multiples, squares and cubes to start the term. By the end of this term year 5 will have secured their use of the formal methods of multiplication and division.

We will move onto the next part of our fractions learning and calculate with fractions allowing us to find fractions of amounts and the whole from a fraction.

Perimeter and Area, and Statistics conclude our term.

Geography
